

The Veterinary Museum



Since its founding in 1978, the museum has acquired over 3,500 artifacts. The collection includes materials and objects from the 16th century to the present. Artifacts, such as manuscripts used by European immigrants, an 1880s trunk filled with dental tools for horses, microscopic slides used by early 20th century veterinary students, a 1920s operating table for small animals, and orthopedic rods and pins used in recent decades, explain the development of veterinary medicine in Missouri.

The museum is open Wednesday through Friday 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. and Saturday by appointment.
